PROCEDURE:

1. World Music and school rep. will determine the theme(s) for the school
2. World Music will set up the display with items in cases (s) at World Music storage building & take a picture, then submit for approval by the school representative
3. School & World Music signs contract
4. World Music delivers & sets up the display at school designated location. When time frame is up, World Music will return to school to unload and remove cases.

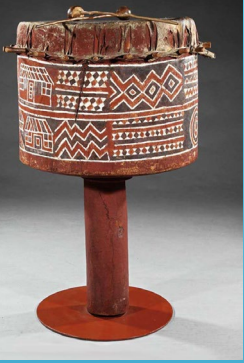
